# PT Alpine Pressurized Fly Bait

A fast-acting, convenient and ready-to-use bait spray for the control of flies with versatility of use in commerical or residential settings. Can be applied as area, band or spot treatment applications and may be used for treatments around window areas, dining rooms, bar areas and other areas where fly control is critical.





### **Treatment Tips for the Use of PT Alpine Pressurized Fly Bait**

**Band Treatment:** Spray from a distance no further away from targeted area than 6 inches to create a band application at a rate of 2 linear feet per second. Band applications may be made to areas such as beam edges, receptacle edges, table or bench edges, around windows and window frames, under narrow eaves and other areas where there is a narrow area where flies land, roost and/or are likely to infest.

Area Treatments: Are effective where flies congregate, roost and feed, which may include garbage receptacles and lids, refuse containers, under tables and benches, recycling bins, dumpsters, behind vending machines, plant or flower pots, under bars, eave areas, walls and/or areas where flies are likely to congregate or infest.

Removable Bait Placements: Spray bait on a small object no larger than 24 square inches and no smaller than 6 square inches. Object may be made of wood, plastic, cardboard, index cards, nylon metal or other suitable material. Place in areas of fly activity and out of reach of children and domestic animals. All removable bait placements must be clearly marked with the wording "Fly Bait, Do Not Touch".

#### Simple to apply; easy to clean up

Reapply when bait placements are no longer visible and/or reinfestation occurs. Use water-dampened paper towel to remove unwanted bait placements and then discard in trash.

Product use within food preparation and food production areas of food handling establishments is limited to the interior of refuse receptacles, removable bait placements or in stations.
